All Hallows, London Wall

All Hallows, London Wall, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Broad Street Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This church was first mentioned in the 12th century, was rebuilt in the 17th and 18th centuries, and repaired in the 1960s. The parish joined with that of St Botolph Bishopsgate in 1954 and All Hallows is now used as a Guild Church. Records of All Hallows, London Wall including registers of baptisms (1559-1875), marriages (1559-1945) and burials (1559-1849) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/ALH5.
