St Andrew Undershaft

St Andrew, Undershaft, St James, Duke's Place, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Aldgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This church was first mentioned in documents in 1147 as St Andrew Cornhill. The parish joined with St Mary Axe in 1561, and then with St James Duke's Place and St Katherine Cree in 1954. Records of St Andrew Undershaft including registers of baptisms (1558-1901), marriages (1558-1970) and burial (1558-1849) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/AND4.
