St Augustine, Watling Street

St Augustine, Watling Street, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Farringdon Within Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

Only the tower and spire survive after the church was first burnt in the Great Fire and the bombed in the Second World War. The parish was united with St Faith under St Pauls in 1670 and both joined St Mary le Bow in 1954. Records of St Augustine, Watling Street including registers of baptisms (1539-1872), marriages (1539-1873) and burials (1539-1853) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/AUG.
