ST ETHELBURGER

St Ethelburger, Bishopsgate

St Ethelburga was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Bishopsgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

Named after a 7th century Abbess of Barking, this ancient church survived the Great Fire and the Second World War only to be destroyed by a terrorist bomb in 1993. Records of St Ethelburga including registers of baptisms (1671-1873), marriages (1679-1837) and burials (1672-1849) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69ETH/.
