



## ST FAITH UNDER ST PAUL

## St Faith under St Paul

St Faith under St Paul was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Farringdon Within Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

St Faith's church was demolished to make room for an extension to St Paul's Cathedral around 1255 and afterwards was given a space in the crypt. After the Great Fire, the parish joined that of St Augustine Watling Street and both then joined St Mary le Bow in 1954. Records of St Faith under St Paul including registers of baptisms (1645-1900), marriages (1647-1837) and burials (1645-1853) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/FAI.
