St Helen, Bishopsgate

St Helen, Bishopsgate, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Bishopsgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

St Helen's was attached to a Benedictine nunnery founded in about 1204 and it carried on parochial work after the Dissolution of the nunnery in 1538. The parish was united with St Martin Outwich in 1874. Records of St Helen Bishopsgate including registers of baptisms (1575-2011), marriages (1575-1870 and 2004-2021) and burials (1575-1853) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/HEL.
