ST JOHN ZACHERY

St John Zachery, Gresham Street

St John Zachary, Gresham Street, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Aldersgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

A church of St John the Baptist was mentioned in 1120. Some 60 years after this the living was given to a man named Zacharie. The church was destroyed in the Great Fire and the parish subsequently joined to that of St Anne and St Agnes in 1670. Records of St John Zachary, including registers of baptisms (1693-1895), marriages (1755-1837) and burials (1693-1849) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/JNZ.
