
ST KATHERINE CREE

St Katherine Cree, Leadenhall Street

St Katherine Cree was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Aldgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

Holy Trinity Priory Aldgate had this church built so that parishioners would not disturb the monks' activities. The parish united with St James Duke's Place in 1873 and then with St Andrew Undershaft and St Mary Axe in 1954.
