ST MAGNUS THE MARTYR

St Magnus the Martyr, Lower Thames Street

St Magnus the Martyr was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Bridge Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

First mentioned in 1067, the church burnt down in the Great Fire and was rebuilt by Wren in the 1670s. Records of St Magnus the Martyr including registers of baptisms (1560-1812), marriages (1557-1991) and burials (1560-1853) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/MAG.
