ST MARY ALDERMARY

St Mary Aldermary, Queen Victoria Street

St Mary, Aldermary, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Cordwainer Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

St Mary, Aldermary, has its origins in the 11th century. It had to be rebuilt after the Great Fire and the parish was joined with that of St Thomas Apostle at this time. In 1875 these parishes joined those of St Antholin and St John the Baptist Walbrook. Records of St Mary, Aldermary, including registers of baptisms (1558-1910), marriages (1558-1940) and burials (1558-1851) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/MRY3.
