St Mary Staining

St Mary Staining was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Aldersgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

The church was destroyed in the Great Fire and the parish united with St Michael Wood Street in 1670 and St Alban Wood Street in 1894. Records of St Mary Staining, including registers of baptisms (1673-1812) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/MRY13.
