ST MARY AT HILL

St Mary at Hill, Lovat Lane

St Mary at Hill was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Billingsgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

Originally founded in the 12th century, this church was damaged by the Great Fire and was rebuilt by Wren. In 1670 the parish was united with the parish of St Andrew Hubbard. Records of St Mary at Hill including registers of baptisms (1558-1988), marriages (1558-1837) and burials (1558-1850) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/MRY4.
