St Olave, Silver Street

St Olave, Silver Street, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Aldersgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

The church, the parish church of the silversmiths, was destroyed in the Great Fire and the parish united with St Michael Wood Street. Records of St Olave, Silver Street, including registers of baptisms (1562-1770), marriages (1562-1680) and burials (1561-1770) are at London Metropolitan Archives, Ref: P69/OLA3.
