All Hallows, Honey Lane

All Hallows, Honey Lane, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Cheap Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This tiny parish was merged with those of St Mary le Bow and St Pancras Soper Lane after its church was destroyed in the Great Fire, with St Mary becoming the parish church. Records of All Hallows, Honey Lane, including registers of baptisms (1538-1697 and 1813-1892), marriages (1546-1666 and 1818-1836) and burials (1538-1666 and 1814-1851) are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/ALH3.
