ALL HALLOWS THE LESS

All Hallows the Less, Upper Thames Street

All Hallows the Less was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Dowgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This church is first mentioned in the records in 1216 and stood over the gateway to a large house. It was destroyed in the Great Fire and the parish was united to All Hallows the Great in 1670. Records of All Hallows the Less including registers of baptisms (1558-1812), marriages (1558-1666) and burials (1558-1812) are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/ALH8.
