St Benet Sherehog

St Benet Sherehog was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Cordwainer Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This church was built before 1111 but was burnt down in the Great Fire and not rebuilt. The parish was united with St Stephen Walbrook in 1670.

Records of St Benet Sherehog are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/BEN4 but do not include any registers of baptisms, marriages or burials.
