ST GABRIEL FENCHURCH

St Gabriel Fenchurch Street

St Gabriel Fenchurch was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Langbourn Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

In 1315 this church was known as St Mary Fenchurch but its name had changed by the end of the 16th century. The church was destroyed during the Great Fire and the parish subsequently joined that of St Margaret Pattens in 1670.
