St John the Baptist, Walbrook

St John the Baptist, Walbrook, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Walbrook Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This church was built around 1150 but burnt down in the Great Fire. The parish was united with St Antholin Budge Row in 1670. Records of St John the Baptist, Walbrook, including registers of baptisms (1682-1812) and burials (1682-1812) are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/JNB.
