ST KATHERINE COLEMAN

St Katherine Coleman, Fenchurch Street

St Katherine Coleman was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Aldgate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This church was thought to have been built by someone called Coleman before 1346. Although it survived the Great Fire, it was rebuilt in 1739. This church was demolished when the parish was united with St Olave Hart Street in 1921.
