St Leonard, East Cheap

St Leonard, East Cheap, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Bridge Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This parish joined that of St Benet Gracechurch in 1670 and the two parishes joined with All Hallows Lombard Street in 1864. These with others joined St Edmund the King and Martyr parish in 1937.
