St Margaret, New Fish Street

St Margaret, New Fish Street was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Bridge Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This church burnt down in the Great Fire and the parish was united with St Magnus the Martyr. Records of St Margaret, New Fish Street are at the London Archives, Ref: P69/MGT3 but do not include any registers of vital events.
