ST MARY BOTHAW

St Mary Bothaw, Cannon Street

St Mary Bothaw was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Walbrook Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This church burnt down in the Great Fire and the parish joined with St Swithin London Stone. Records of St Mary Bothaw, including registers of baptisms (1536-1654), marriages (1536-1658 and 1754-1812) and burials (1536-1653) are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/MRY6.

Cannon Street railway station was built on the site in the 19th century.
