St Mary Magdalen, Milk Street

St Mary Magdalen, Milk Street, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Cripplegate Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

The church of St Mary Magdalen burn down in the Great Fire and the parish was subsequently joined to that of St Lawrence Jewry. Records of St Mary Magdalen, Milk Street including registers of baptisms (1558-1666), marriages (1559-1666) and burials (1558-1666) are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/MRY9.
