



ST MARY MAGDALEN, OLD FISH STREET

St Mary Magdalen, Old Fish Street

St Mary Magdalen, Old Fish Street, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Castle Baynard Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

St Mary Magdalen's 12th century church burnt down in the Great Fire and although rebuilt by Wren, it was again damaged by fire in 1886 and was consequently demolished. The parish was united with St Martin Ludgate in 1890. Records of St Mary Magdalen, Old Fish Street, including registers of baptisms (1539-1892), marriages (1539-1886) and burials (1539-1853) are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/MRY10.
