ST MARY MOUNTHAW

St Mary Mounthaw, Fish Street Hill

St Mary Mounthaw, Fish Street Hill, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Queenhithe Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

Originally a private chapel for the Montenhaut family, this building was destroyed in the Great Fire and in 1670 the parish was united to St Mary Somerset. Records of St Mary Mounthaw, including registers of baptisms (1568-1887), marriages (1568-1666 and 1754-1878) and burials (1568-1849) are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/MRY11.
