## St Michael Bassishaw

St Michael Bassishaw was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Bassishaw Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

The church had to be demolished in 1897 after the foundations were damaged whilst the crypt was being cleared on human remains. The parish united with St Lawrence Jewry. Records of St Michael Bassishaw including registers of baptisms (1538-1892), marriages (1539-1890) and burials (1539-1853) are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/MIC1.
