## ST NICHOLAS OLAVE

### St Nicholas Olave Bread Street Hill

St Nicholas Olave, Bread Street Hill, was an ancient parish in the City of London and formed part of Queenhithe Ward. Each ward has an elected alderman and supporting councilmen in the City of London Corporation which has administered the City since before the Norman Conquest and is still doing so today.

This church was destroyed in the Great Fire and the parish united with St Nicholas Cole Abbey in 1670. Records of St Nicholas Olave including registers of baptisms (1704-1936), marriages (1705-1720 and 1813-1836) and burials (1704-1852) are at The London Archives, Ref: P69/NIC3.
